

Dear Mr. Winter:

This letter is to again request that plaintiffs be provided with information on proposed purchase price and rental ranges for dwelling units either currently being constructed or proposed for construction in Edison. You will recall that toward the end of oral argument on September 24, 1976, the Court stated "that more specific information as to rentals, for example, or multi-family housing details suggesting that low and moderate income units can be built may be supplied by the municipalities. . . ."  
Over a month ago, on September 27, 1976, I wrote to you requesting such information. To date I have received no response.

The oral argument on the issue of your compliance with the judgment is scheduled for November 19. As supporting briefs are due very soon, I would appreciate your supplying the requested information by no later than the end of this week.
