
Thank you for your letter of November 5, 1975, requesting admissions in regards to various documents.

This is to respectfully advise you that I cannot admit to the authenticity of those documents since they are records that only go up to 1969-1970. Due to the tremendous change in the economy, building practices, cost of living and employment, I do not consider those statistics to be valid at this time.

Another reason for not accepting these statistics is that I am not aware of the method of determining these statistics, the questions that were asked and how the responses were analyzed.

I think the invalidity of statistics and the conclusions that can be drawn from them were clearly brought out at the conference that was held with the Middlesex County Planning Board on the housing needs of the County.
