

at 1:30 p.m., the undersigned, attorney for defendant, Township
Committee of the Township of North Brunswick, will move before
the Honorable David D. Furman, at the Court House, New Brunswick,
New Jersey for an Order severing the party defendant, Township
Committee of the Township of North Brunswick, from the within
action for the following reasons:

(a) The complaint does not set forth a common question
of law or fact as against the defendant.

(b) A single consolidated trial against the within
named twenty-three defendants would be prejudicial and an undue

financial burden upon the defendant, Township Committee of the Township of North Brunswick, since the factual questions in the plaintiff's suit against the Township Committee of the Township of North Brunswick are distinctly different than the factual questions raised against the other defendants.
