I have enclosed an original and two copies of the proposed Consent Order which I discussed with you on the telephone.

As you requested, I wish to advise that the Township Committee authorized in my presence Paul Keller, a professional planner who is director of the Department of Planning and Development, to work on an amended zoning ordinance that would comply with the Judgment by October 6th. As you know, the delay in the entry of the Order of Judgment through the work period in the summer months and vacations by Planning Board members and Mr. Keller himself have delayed matters. In August there was a joint meeting of the Planning Board and Township Committee for the purpose of complying with the Judgment. I know the Township Committee also intends to have another joint meeting with the Planning Board as soon as possible to discuss the proposals which Mr. Keller will present. What has happened is that the various Township boards and officials simply would be unduly pressed in order to meet the deadline. If you would like any further information, please let me know.
