Dear Mr. Karcher:

It is with a mixture of shock and regret that we read your letter of December 30 stating that the Borough of Sayreville will not make the changes to which you agreed in our conversation of December 22 unless plaintiffs consent to the entry of an order of dismissal. At no time prior to your letter did you ever state that such consent was a pre-condition to the effectuation of these changes. Certainly, plaintiffs made it abundantly clear in our conversation that there were several other issues of some significance which were not resolved during the conference call. It would be premature for plaintiffs to agree to a consent order at this time without further evidence that the fair share goal will be provided.

Plaintiffs have made a sincere and concerted effort to reach an accommodation with the Borough on our differences. We did not expect it to be difficult to resolve the issues which still divide us. But apparently the Borough feels otherwise. We regret that decision on the Borough's part.
