


WHEREAS, the South Brunswick Planning Board received a Demonstration Housing Grant from the N. J.Department of Community Affairs providing assistance for a housing study in April, 1974; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Carl E. Hintz, South Brunswick Director of Planning and Development and Mr. Edgar Brannon, of Cook College, Rutgers University, prepared a segment dealing with review of planned residential development; and

WHEREAS, the South Brunswick Planning Board entered into an agreement in April, 1974 with Abeles and Schwartz Associates, of New York, N. Y., to prepare a segment of the study dealing with housing; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Board has read and reviewed the study at numerous public work sessions with the consultants and Mr. Hintz and has made recommendations for improved drafts;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, on this 27th day of May, 1975, by the South Brunswick Planning Board, that the final draft of the study, as submitted to the Board by Messrs. Hintz, Brannon and the firm of Abeles and Schwartz Associates, is hereby accepted, subject to the following change: information on the Farmers Home Administration Assistance for housing.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be sent to the South Brunswick Township Committee, Abeles and Schwartz Associates and the N.J. Department of Community Affairs - Housing Demonstration Program.
