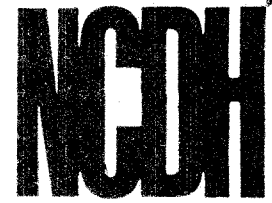


1. I am an attorney for the plaintiffs in the above captioned case.

2. On October 14, 1974, plaintiffs served by first class mail, postage prepaid from Washington, D.C. interrogatories on all defendants, each of which has signed a return receipt request.


3. The answers to such interrogatories were due on December 16, 1974, 63 days after service.

4. On January 7, 1974 and February 12, 1975, plaintiffs notified by letter those defendants which had not responded to the interrogatories that a motion to strike answers would be filed unless plaintiffs received responses.

5. As of February 21, 1975, defendants Carteret, Madison, ~~South Plainfield~~, Spotswood and Woodbridge have not answered interrogatories, have not made a proper objection thereto, nor have they moved for an order enlarging time.
