urban county grant application as well as present HUD program  
applications.


2. The 1975 CDRS Allocations by Project/Category attached to Appendix I of the Trial Brief of the conditionally dismissed municipalities demonstrates the initial funding to the Borough from the urban county grant. This \$5,000.00 allocation is for the purpose of rehabilitation of an area along the "Causeway", a low/moderate income neighborhood of the Borough. As the Court can see from the said 1975 CDRA Allocations, South River is one of five of the 20 municipalities jointly participating as an "urban county" to have designated initial funding for the purpose of rehabilitation.

3. Moreover, the Borough of South River received, on March 19, 1976, a permit from the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, which will allow for construction of an interceptor sewer in the "South End" of the Borough. See attached letter of approval. This sewer construction project, which will service the older section of the Borough, where low/moderate income families of the Borough reside, is to be funded largely by HUD monies under an application by the Borough. Rehabilitation and redevelopment of these older areas of the Borough is dependent on first installing and completing

this south end interceptor sewer since presently developed facilities, which may be substandard, are being serviced by substandard sewer lines.
