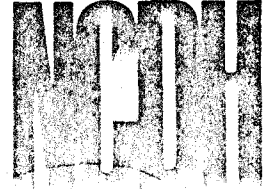


Dear Judge Furman:

This is in response to the zoning ordinance amendment submitted by defendant South River on May 3, 1976, and the letter to you dated May 14, 1976 and received by us on May 17, 1976 from Gary M. Schwartz, counsel for defendant South River enclosing a "Five Day Order."

At our request, Mr. Mallach reviewed the zoning ordinance amendment. He found it unacceptable in numerous respects, and plaintiffs adopt his comments as a formal objection to such amendment as satisfying the terms of the dismissal procedure outlined in your opinion. A copy of Mr. Mallach's comments are enclosed.

Plaintiffs therefore object to the provisions of the proposed order, and request that such order be included in the argument scheduled for May 28.
