
Dear Judge Furman:

The Township of Woodbridge is in receipt of Mr. Searing's most recent Motion for costs.

Please be advised that the Township opposes the relief sought, primarily for two reasons. First, the relief sought is substantially similar to that which plaintiffs earlier scheduled for August 27, 1976, but was ultimately entertained on September 24, 1976. At that time, the requested costs were denied. Second, and perhaps more importantly, this matter is now before the appellate division as a result of the various appeals filed by plaintiffs and certain of the defendants. Consequently, it is respectfully contended that the Chancery Division no longer has jurisdiction to entertain the plaintiff's Motion.
