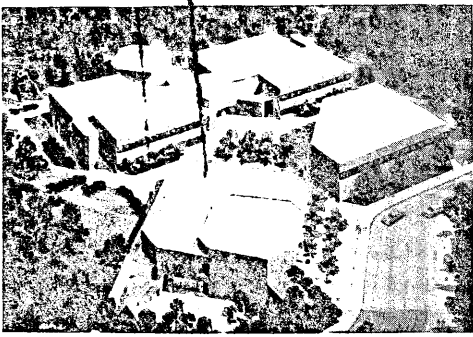

CDBG Rehab Facts

F.Y.I.

- Started September, 1980
- Spent \$447,000+
- Helped over 115 applicants
- Grants range up to \$1,000.00
- No-interest loans from \$1,000 upwards
  - lien put on house for amount of work done
  - only is repaid when title changes
- must assist low/moderate income peoples  
(see attached guidelines)
- must: alleviate building, health or safety code violations  
improve neighborhoods, and/or assist minorities,  
elderly and disabled
- applications available from this office
- available for owner-occupied homes and handicapped renters

Heads of households over 62 years of age or handicapped will have 10% of the gross household income subtracted for this Program's purposes.
