FOR A STAY AND TEMPORARY REMAND


PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Civic League plaintiffs hereby  
move for an Order as follows: (1) To stay the Orders dated  
October 6, 1987 and April 21, 1988, pursuant to R. 2:9-5, insofar  
as such Orders permit defendant Old Bridge Planning Board to  
consider applications of plaintiffs Olympia & York Old Bridge

Development Corporation and Woodhaven Village, Inc., pending the resolution of the within appeal; (2) That the defendant Planning Board be further ordered to provide the Civic League plaintiffs with Planning Board agendas pending the resolution of the within appeal; (3) For a temporary remand to the trial court for a plenary hearing in connection with newly discovered evidence pursuant to R. 4:50-1 and (4) following remand, that the within appeal be expedited.
