I have enclosed a draft of our letter to South Brunswick in response to its submission of its current and proposed ordinances. Please review the letter and provide me with your comments next week. I have some particular questions concerning its ordinances and proposed amendments•

1. Are the mobile home and manufactured zones in suitable locations and probable of some development?

2. Does making the manufactured zone a conditional use in an industrial zone effectively negate its usefulness?

3. Is sufficient, appropriate land zoned for high density?

4. Did South Brunswick's former mandatory set-aside for planned unit residential development produce any low and/or moderate income housing?

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5. Did I miss any cost-producing provisions? (e.g. is a 40% open space requirement too much; should all residential clusters have immediate access to a major collector or arterial road)?
