I find the following mathematical errors in the May 10, 1984 report of George Raymond

PAGE TWO

Paragraph c: This figure should be 45 units rather than 44 units.

PAGE FIVE

Paragraph b(2): This figure should be 677 units rather than 676 units.

Paragraph c: This figure should be 568 units rather than 563 units.

Paragraph d: This figure should be 578 units rather than 574 units.

PAGE SEVEN

Paragraph b(2): This should be 597 units instead of 593 units.

PAGE EIGHT

Paragraph d(1): This paragraph should be 514 units rather than 513 units.

Paragraph d(2): This paragraph should be 572 units rather than 571 units.

PAGE NINE

The mid-point for the six county region should be 666 units rather than 665 units.


