BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Helmetta, County of Middlesex, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION I. The annual salaries, compensation, and wages shall be paid to the various Borough Officials and Employees of the Borough of Helmetta be and the same are hereby fixed in the following amount as of January 1, 1975.

a). Full time employees who have been employed for at least six (6) months in a full-time capacity, ten (10) days vacation during the calendar year 1975.

b). Full time employees who have been employed for at least five (5) years in a full-time capacity, fifteen (15) days vacation during the calendar year 1975.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. All Policemen will receive overtime pay at their straight salary rate for any hours in excess of forty (40) worked in any week provided, however, that no more than \$1,250.00 in overtime pay shall be paid to any policeman in any calendar year.
