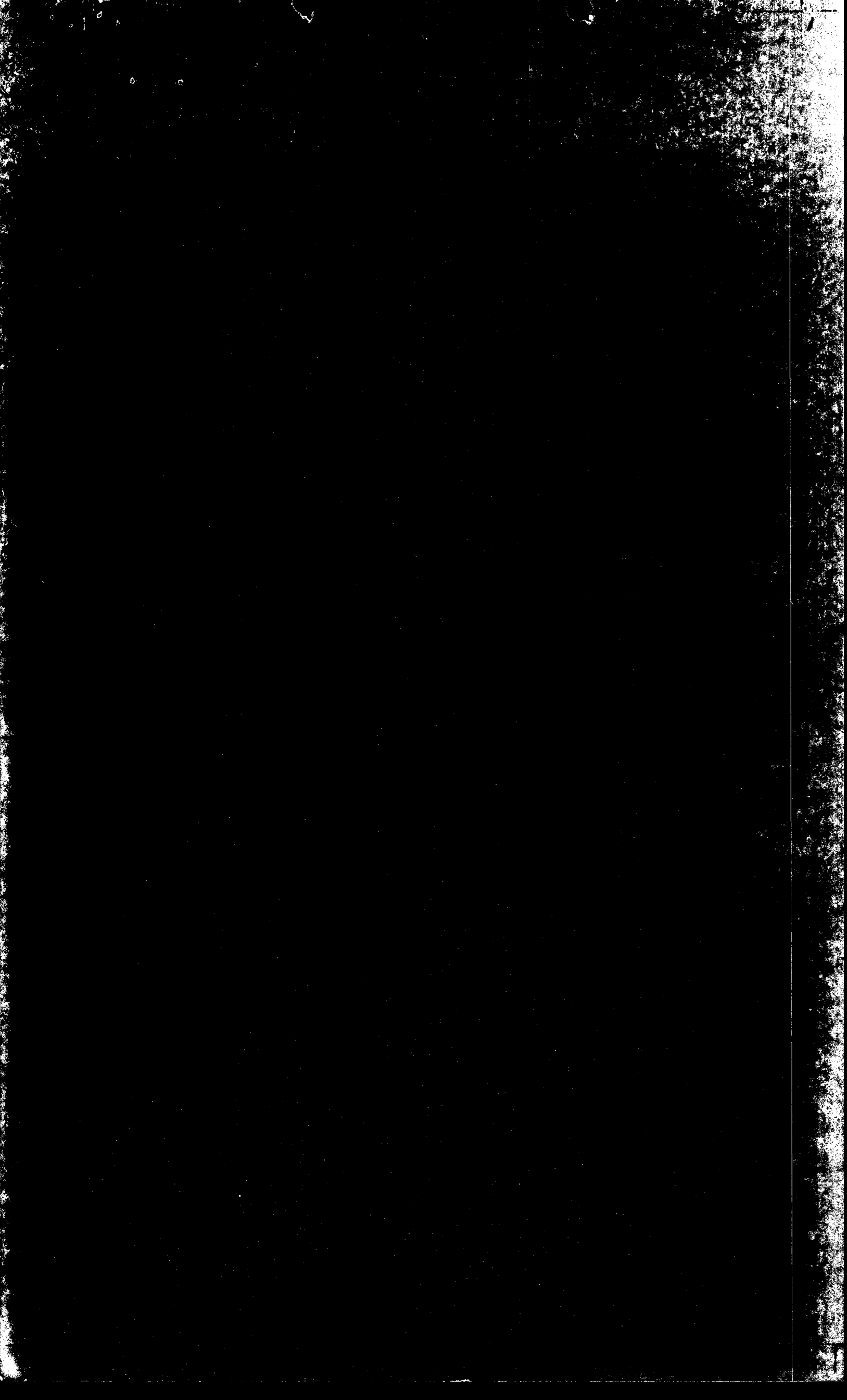

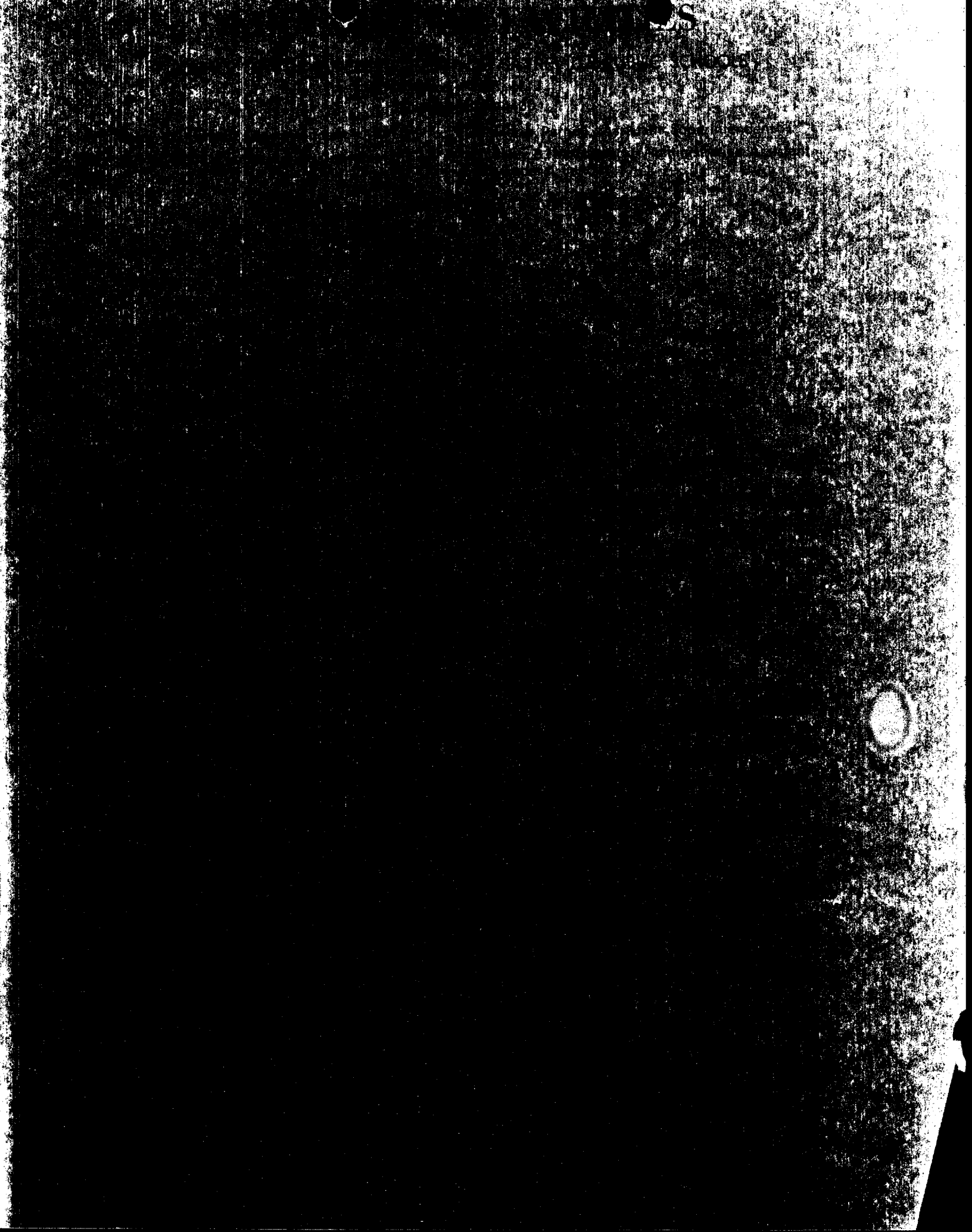
7. Provide for each department in the municipality the number of municipal employees by job category, race, and annual salary or hourly wage.




