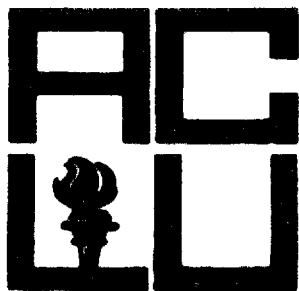

Enclosed are three copies of the ACLU's standard retainer in connection with the new Edison case. You will note that I have incorporated in the retainer the understanding that the ACLU's obligation at this point is only to initiate the suit to prompt COAH processing. We cannot promise representation before COAH nor can we assure continued representation if by chance the matter is not transferred to COAH and stays in court. Assuming this meets with your understanding and is satisfactory, please sign all three retainers and, when you see John, have him sign all three. You should keep one copy, he should get one, and one should be returned to me for our files.

We are very excited about the new suit and hope that you will stop the Rivertown project and get Edison moving in the right direction. I hope to see Edison on the centerfold next year!
