
Dear Judge Serpentelli:

I am in receipt of correspondence to Your Honor from Carl Bisgaier dated June 6, 1984 relative to the consolidated Mount Laurel lawsuits presently pending against the Township of Holmdel. As I have not been privy to much of what has apparently transpired in that litigation, I refrain from making any comment in that regard. However, I would like to comment upon the scheduling order proposed by Mr. Bisgaier in his June 6th letter.

Since the New Brunswick-Hampton, Inc. v. Holmdel Mount Laurel suit is to be tried on a consolidated basis with the Real Estate Equities, Inc. matter, the proposed scheduled order would cause great difficulty for me, inasmuch as I am scheduled to be in Europe from June 23, 1984 to July 8, 1984. In light of these longstanding vacation plans, it would be extremely difficult for this office to comply with the scheduling order proposed by Mr. Bisgaier for the Holmdel litigation.

Accordingly, I would respectfully request that a scheduling order be entered which would afford me a reasonable opportunity and adequate time to to comply with the various deadlines.
