

This will confirm our telephone conversation of Thursday, September 13, 1984.

It is my understanding that the governing body of the Township of Monroe has formally decided not to comply with the Court order requiring revision of its land use ordinances to comply with Mount Laurel requirements in order to satisfy its fair share, in accordance with the prior findings of this Court.

Based upon your representation of those facts, I am hereby directing that you appear before the Court on Tuesday, September 18, 1984 at 9:30. In addition, I am requesting, though not directing, that the Mayor and all members of the governing body attend the hearing to be held at that time. By copy of this letter I am advising plaintiffs' counsel of the hearing so that they may attend as well.
