RE: Telephone conversation with Marip Apuzzo, July 9, 1985

I telephoned Mario Apuzzo on July 9, 1985 and asked him whether I was going to get a response to my request. He said he was sending me a letter indicating attorney-client privilege was being waived.

I asked him if he attended the meeting regarding Wittingham. He said yes and that to his knowledge there was no set-aside in the project. Council followed the recommendation and approved the project 5-0.

He said the minutes contained the resolutions, discussion, etc. and were on file and public information. Planning Board Clerk is Donna Appleby. Council minutes and resolution are in process of being prepared.

He further stated he was in a sensitive situation. He took orders from his client. I then asked him who his client was. He said as Director of Law he represented the Mayor, he also represented Council but through the Mayor. I asked him whose attorney-client privilege was being waived. He indicated only that of the Mayor. If the Mayor could not answer my questions he would reach the question of waiver by Council.
