1. The Supplemental Agreement and implementing ordinances  
and the proposed agreed-upon modifications thereto and to the

original Negotiated Settlement are found to be sufficiently within the possible range of approval to justify further proceedings.

2. A hearing shall be held at \*j ' Jh / ^ \* on Jfy \ < Wx lh \$ \ f. I I , 1985, for the purpose of considering approval of the following:

- a) . Supplemental Agreement and implementing ordinances embodying the conditions set forth in the Order of the Court, dated October 31, 1984?
- b) Proposed agreed-upon modifications to the original Negotiated Settlement, the Supplemental Agreement and implementing ordinances

and entry of a judgment of compliance in favor of Lincoln Park Borough

3. All papers in support of entry of judgment of compliance on the basis of this agreement shall be filed on or before /ju.C.twV /J5 1985, and served on all parties to the above entitled suit.

4. All objections to entry of a judgment of compliance on the basis of this modified agreement shall be filed on or before \$ \ VL % M - & \ + ' V ^ , 1985, and served on counsel for Lincoln Park Borough, and Morris County Fair Housing Council, et al.

5. Reply briefs and supporting papers may be filed by proponents of entry of judgment or objections on or before ^Cftfefo.heY' (c2, 1985.

6. The parties shall give notice of the modified agreement to interested persons, and entities by:



- (4) Legal Aid Society of Morris County.
- (5) Urban League of Morris County.
- (6) Pending applicants for development, and any other developer or property owner who has expressed an interest in constructing low income housing.

Park Borough Clerk and the offices of counsel for Lincoln Park
