THIS MATTER HAVING BEEN OPENED to the Court upon the request of Kirsten, Friedman & Cherin, a Professional Corporation, Attorneys for the Defendant, TOWNSHIP OF PISCATAWAY, Phillip Lewis Paley, Esq., appearing, with reference to the need for a clarification of the Order entered by this Court in
