

The parties having reached a settlement in this matter which is contingent upon the court issuing a judgment of compliance and such settlement being subject to the approval of the court for reasons set forth in the court's opinion in Morris County Fair Housing Council, et al v. Boonton Township, 197 Ell- super- 359 (1984), and the court having determined that the assistance of an advisory master is needed to determine whether the settlement should be approved and to assist the defendant in preparing an amended ordinance witch complies with the requirements of the Mount Laurel doctrine;

It is on this }f}~ day of March, 1984 ORDERED that Alan Mallach is appointed as an advisory master (1) to provide recommendations to the court as to whether to approve the settlement reached between the parties, (2) to assist the defendant in developing an amended ordinance which will bring about compliance with Mount Laurel, and (3) to provide recommendations to the court as to whether the amended ordinance achieves compliance with Mount Laurel. Compensation shall be at the rate of \$80.00 per hour.
