INTRODUCTION

This preliminary report is the result of an analysis of the value of residential properties within the Township of Roxbury. Based on this preliminary analysis, a more detailed study will be made when the necessary computer readouts of the Roxbury Tax Book are made available from the computer data center.

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PURPOSE

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Before it is possible to determine the "Housing Allocation" figure for low and moderate income households in a given community, a necessary first step is to determine the existing housing stock in the community. Data is available for the year 1978 to make such an analysis for the Township of Roxbury. Based on the data listed in the Sources cited above, a preliminary analysis has been made for the Township of Roxbury for the year 1978.

PROCEDURE

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The number of Class 2 properties (that is, real estate housing not more than four families) with a market value of \$50,000 or less was determined. No deductions were made to account for oversized lots, accessory buildings such as detached garages and sheds; decks or porches. Thus, these preliminary figures would tend to understate the number of residential units priced under \$50,000.

PRELIMINARY RESULTS

The preliminary analysis shows that for Class 2 properties in the Township of Roxbury for the Year 1978:

48.5% valued at less than \$50,000 24.8% valued at less than \$40,000 12.1% valued at less than \$32,000

If one assumes a linear relationship for properties priced between \$40,000 and \$50,000, the percentage of units priced below \$42,000 would be 29.5%.
