Your letter of January 7th, 1980 to Judge Gaynor has been referred to me for reply since Judge Schoch has assigned me as Judge in charge of the civil calendar.

I have reviewed this matter with the Assignment Clerk's Office and have determined that there should be no delay in the scheduled trial date of February 19th.

First let me correct an error in the second paragraph of the second page of your letter of January 7th. You give the date of February 16, 1980 for a preliminary conference in the Bedminster case. The correct date is January 16th.
