PROTECTIVE ORDER

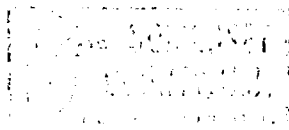
This matter having been opened to the Court by Susan L. Spagna, Attorney for AT&T Long Lines, on an application for costs, and a protective order pursuant to Rule 4:10-3 with regard to certain subpoenaed documents setting forth a description of all employees by residence and salary range at the AT&T Long Lines facility in Bedminster Township, N.J., and the Court having heard the oral argument of counsel and for good cause shown:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED on this 17<sup>th</sup> day of October, 1978, that all parties to this action shall ensure the privacy and confidentiality of the information contained in the subpoenaed documents and shall not disclose the documents or information contained therein to any persons not a party hereto or witness herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that AT&T Long Lines shall be reimbursed for the cost of preparing the subpoenaed documents in the amount of \$966.00. The proportionate share of the cost among the parties shall be determined by the Court at a later time.
