



- 9. The Hills Development Company joins in the Motion for stay of Attilio Pillon and also independently by the within Motion requests a stay of all proceedings in the case of Leonard Dobbs v. Township of Bedminster.
- 10. Since any further proceedings in the case of Dobbs v. Bedminster would in effect render the Hills Development Company's pending appeal moot and additionally foreclose Hills Development Company from any reasonable participation in the discovery process and other pretrial proceedings in this case, a Motion for stay of Dobbs v. Bedminster is respectfully requested.
