#### MEMORANDUM TO ALL COUNSEL IN BEDMINISTER CASE

This will confirm the results of the pretrial conference held on October 31, 1984. The conference was called for the purpose of preparing for trial which is to commence on November 5, 1984. The two issues to be tried are compliance and the right of Dobbs to a builder's remedy.

With respect to compliance, the burden of proof is on the Township. Its witnesses shall be in the order listed:

- 1. George Raymond
- 2. Richard Coppola
- 3. Alan Mallach
- 4. A representative of the Planning Board
- 5. John Kerwin

Dobbs shall present the following witnesses concerning compliance:

- 1. John Wallace
- 2. John Hordon
- 3. Leonard Dobbs
- 4. a witness to be named concerning section 202 housing.

Both sides reserve the right to present rebuttal witnesses.

Upon completion of the compliance aspect of the trial, we will commence the builder's remedy aspect unless the Court otherwise directs. Before hearing proofs, the Court will entertain a motion from the Township to dismiss the claim for builder's remedy as a matter of law. In the event that the motion is denied, Dobbs shall proceed with its proofs as to its entitlement to a remedy and its witnesses shall be Messrs. Wallace, Hordon and Dobbs, as listed above, and possibly a representative of the Green Acres program. The defendant Township shall offer the testimony of Mr. Coppola, a representative of the planning Board, a custodial of records of the Township and Ms. O'Brien.

It was agreed that the following may be marked in evidence without additional proofs:

- 1. All expert reports submitted by any party except for the report of Kupper Associates dated October, 1984.
- 2. Compliance agreement dated October 29, 1984 with attachments.
- 3. The site identification map and zoning map prepared by Mr. Coppola.

Each party is to prepare a letter setting forth each report relied upon by the party so that the Court may verify that it is in possession of those reports and pre-mark them in evidence. Each party shall also enclose in that letter, a description of any exhibits to be relied upon by any expert witness so that such exhibits can be marked in evidence without further proofs, if agreed upon.

The trial shall continue for everyday that the Court is in session, until completion, including Fridays. The Court will not be in session on the following dates:

Tuesday, November 6, Monday, November 12, Thursday, November 15, The entire week commencing November 19, and Tuesday, November 27

Trial shall start at 9:30 of each day that the Court is in session.
