I wish to acknowledge your letter of September 19, 1983.

I regret to say that I cannot give you any definitive answer to the questions you raise. Based upon my most recent discussion with Judge Skillman, I understand that no trial date has been set in the Morris County matter. Since we have a pretrial on October 25, 1983 with respect to the above referenced cases, I would anticipate setting a trial date at that time.

With respect to any determination by Judge Skillman in the Morris County matter and its effect on non-participating litigants, I believe that he would agree with me that it has presumptive validity but that it would not be binding on me since we are both trial level judges.

The problem which you raise exists in numerous Mount Laurel cases. I can only assure you that the three Mount Laurel judges are keenly aware of conflicting regional definitions and that we are striving for uniformity within the limits of our abilities to reach a just result in each individual case.
