

This matter having been opened to the Court upon Motion of J. Albert Mastro, Attorney for Defendant, Planning Board of Far Hills, in which Motion Schaff, Motiuk and Hornby, Esqs., Attorneys for Defendants Borough of Far Hills and the Mayor and Council of Far Hills have joined; in the presence of Vogel and Chait, Esqs., Attorneys for Plaintiffs; and the Court having read the moving (and opposing) papers and for good cause shown;

It is on this 29th day of September, 1983, ORDERED that defendants be permitted to file amendments to their respective answers as more particularly appears in the form of amendment attached to the moving documents.

It is further ORDERED that paragraph seven of the pretrial order is hereby amended to add the following issues: deprivation of property rights contrary to Art. I, Sec. I of the New Jersey Const.; Due Process of law and Equal Protection of the laws under the Fourteenth Amendment to the United States Const.; separation of powers under Art. III of the New Jersey Const.; deprivation of the right to petition for redress of grievances pursuant to Art. I, Sec. 18 of the New Jersey Const.
