

CHAPTER 130

AN ACT requiring paid leave for members of certain law enforcement associations who attend conventions and amending N.J.S.11A:6-10.

BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:*

1. N.J.S.11A:6-10 is amended to read as follows:

Leaves of absence for convention attendance.

11A:6-10. A leave of absence with pay shall be given to every employee who is a duly authorized representative of the New Jersey Patrolmen's Benevolent Association, Inc., Fraternal Order of Police, Firemen's Mutual Benevolent Association, Inc., the Fire Fighters Association of New Jersey, the New Jersey Law Enforcement Supervisors Association, the New Jersey Superior Officers Law Enforcement Association, the New Jersey Superior Officers Law Enforcement Association-Captains Unit, the International Association of Women Police or the New Jersey State Association of Chiefs of Police, or to any corrections officer who is a member of the Italian American Police Society of New Jersey to attend any State or national convention of the organization. The leave of absence shall be for a period inclusive of the duration of the convention with a reasonable time allowed for travel to and from the convention. A certificate of attendance at the convention shall, upon request, be submitted by the representative so attending.

2. This act shall take effect immediately.
