

CHAPTER 47

A SUPPLEMENT to "An Act making appropriations for the support of the State Government and the several public purposes for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001 and regulating the disbursement thereof," approved June 30, 2000 (P.L.2000, c.53).

BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

1. In addition to the amounts appropriated under P.L.2000, c.53, there is appropriated out of the General Fund the following sum for the purpose specified:

The funds appropriated hereinabove shall be provided: (1) pursuant to an agreement entered into between the Department of Education, the Lakewood School District, and Lakewood Township that shall provide for Lakewood Township to allocate additional funds to the district for the 2000-2001 school year in an amount equal to \$1,000,000; and (2) contingent upon the submission of a corrective action plan by the Lakewood School District which is to be implemented by the district, to be approved by the Commissioner of Education, and which addresses the recommendations contained in the Comprehensive Operational Performance Assessment Report issued by the Department of Education. The commissioner shall transmit to the Senate Budget and Appropriations Committee and the Assembly Appropriations Committee, or their successors, a copy of the Report upon its completion, but not later than October 1, 2001. Of the appropriated amount, \$150,000 shall be allocated to the Department of Education for the appointment of a State monitor of the Lakewood School District or any other oversight measures required by the commissioner

2. This act shall take effect immediately.
