

CHAPTER 150

AN ACT concerning jointure commissions and amending N.J.S.18A:46-25.

BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:*

1. N.J.S.18A:46-25 is amended to read as follows:

Jointure commissions for education and training under this chapter.

18A:46-25. When two or more boards of education determine to carry out jointly by agreement the duties imposed upon them in regard to the education and training of disabled pupils, and counseling, inclusionary, and child study team services for, but not limited to, disabled pupils, the boards may, in accordance with rules and regulations of the State board, and with the approval of the commissioner by the adoption of similar resolutions establish a jointure commission for the purpose of providing such services. The commission shall, in accordance with rules of the State board, be composed of representatives of the respective boards of education, and shall organize by the election of a president and vice president.

The counseling services provided by a jointure commission to a nondisabled pupil shall be limited to preventive counseling services.

2. This act shall take effect immediately.
