

**CHAPTER 300**

**A SUPPLEMENT** to "An Act making appropriations for the support of the State Government and the several public purposes for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006 and regulating the disbursement thereof," approved July 2, 2005 (P.L.2005, c.132).

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

1. In addition to the amounts appropriated under P.L.2005, c.132, there are appropriated out of the General Fund the following sums for the purposes specified:

**54 DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES**  
**50 Economic Planning, Development and Security**  
**53 Economic Assistance and Security**  
**7550 Division of Family Development**

**GRANTS-IN-AID**

15-7550 Income Maintenance Management .....	<u>\$4,000,000</u>
Total Grants-in-Aid Appropriation, Division of Family Development .....	<u>\$4,000,000</u>

**Grants-in-Aid:**

- 15 New Jersey Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (NJ LIHEAP) ..... (\$3,000,000)
- 15 Social Services for the Homeless ... (1,000,000)

The amount appropriated above for the New Jersey Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program shall be allocated in proportion to the State benefit amounts otherwise distributed to eligible families through the State LIHEAP program to meet winter 2005-2006 home heating costs.

The amount above appropriated for Social Services for the Homeless shall be used exclusively to offset the increase in the cost of home heating.
