

CHAPTER 307

AN ACT concerning the disclosure of certain information regarding applicants for or holders of certain licenses and supplementing P.L.1978, c.73 (C.45:1-14 et seq.).

BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:*

C.45:1-21.4 Certain information relative to address of certain applicants, licensees; nondisclosure.

1. Notwithstanding any other law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the director or a board shall not disclose to the public information indicating the place of residence of any applicant for or holder of a license, registration or certification without the consent of the applicant or holder, except for such disclosure to a federal or State regulatory authority or a law enforcement or judicial authority.

2. The director, pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Act," P.L.1968, c.410 (C.52:14B-1 et seq.), may adopt rules and regulations to effectuate the purposes of this act.

3. This act shall take effect immediately, and shall apply to an individual holder of a license, registration or certification upon the issuance or renewal of that individual's license, registration or certification which takes place on or after the first day of the thirteenth month following enactment.
