

CHAPTER 104

A SUPPLEMENT to "An Act making appropriations for the support of the State Government and the several public purposes for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009 and regulating the disbursement thereof," approved June 30, 2008 (P.L.2008, c.35).

BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and the General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of P.L.2008, c.22 (C.52:9H-2.1 et al.), there is appropriated from the Long Term Obligation and Capital Expenditure Fund the sum of \$12,500,000 for the following purposes: to the Department of Community Affairs, for a grant in the amount of \$2,500,000 to the New Jersey Housing and Mortgage Finance Agency for mortgage counseling; to the Department of Community Affairs for a grant in the amount of \$9,500,000 to the New Jersey Housing and Mortgage Finance Agency for foreclosure mediation; and to the Administrative Office of the Courts the amount of \$500,000 for foreclosure mediation.

2. Upon certification by the Director of the Division of Budget and Accounting in the Department of the Treasury that federal funds to support the expenditures listed below are available, the following sum is appropriated:
