

## CHAPTER 108

AN ACT concerning duplicate driver's licenses and identification cards and supplementing P.L.1979, c.261 (C.39:3-10f et seq.) and P.L.1980, c.47 (C.39:3-29.2 et seq.).

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

C.39:3-10f7 Waiver of fee for replacement driver's license for organ, tissue donor.

1. a. Notwithstanding any law, rule, or regulation to the contrary, the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission shall not impose a fee for a replacement driver's license or the digitized picture fee if the replacement driver's license is requested solely for the purpose of designating that the person shall donate all or any organs or tissues for the purposes of transplantation or therapy pursuant to section 1 of P.L.1978, c.181 (C.39:3-12.2).

b. In order to receive a replacement driver's license, pursuant to subsection a. of this section, a person shall first surrender the person's current driver's license to the commission.

C.39:3-29.7a Waiver of fee for duplicate identification card, digitized picture fee for organ, tissue donors.

2. a. Notwithstanding any law, rule, or regulation to the contrary, the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission shall not impose a fee for a duplicate identification card or the digitized picture fee if the duplicate identification card is requested solely for the purpose of designating that the person shall donate all or any organs or tissues for the purposes of transplantation or therapy pursuant to section 1 of P.L.1978, c.181 (C.39:3-12.2).

b. In order to receive a replacement identification card, pursuant to subsection a. of this section, a person shall first surrender the person's current identification card to the commission.

3. This act shall take effect on the first day of the third month following enactment.
