

CHAPTER 122

AN ACT designating a portion of New Jersey Route 47 as “Veterans Memorial Highway at Delsea Drive.”

BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:*

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of P.L.1940, J.R.2 which designated New Jersey Route No. 47 as “Delsea Drive,” the Commissioner of Transportation shall designate the section of New Jersey Route No. 47 extending from Milepost 0 in Wildwood City, Cape May County to Milepost 35.08 in Maurice River Township in Cumberland County as "Veterans Memorial Highway at Delsea Drive" and erect appropriate signs along that section of New Jersey Route No. 47 bearing this name.

2. No State or other public funds shall be used for producing, purchasing, erecting, or maintaining signs bearing the designation established pursuant to section 1 of this act. The Commissioner of Transportation is authorized to receive gifts, grants, or other financial assistance from private sources for the purposes of funding or reimbursing the Department of Transportation for the costs associated with producing, purchasing, erecting, and maintaining signs bearing the designation established pursuant to section 1 of this act and entering into agreements related thereto, with such private sources including but not limited to non-governmental non-profit, educational or charitable entities or institutions. No work shall proceed, and no funding shall be accepted by the Department of Transportation until an agreement has been reached with a responsible party for paying the costs associated with producing, purchasing, erecting, and maintaining the signs.

3. This act shall take effect immediately.
